The Licking County Soil & Water Conservation District (SWCD) is seeking an energetic and motivated individual to fill the position of **Stormwater Educator/Outreach Coordinator**. This position will be responsible for promoting and educating the community about stormwater management and environmental conservation efforts, supporting initiatives that enhance the quality of water resources in Licking County. The successful candidate will have the opportunity to lead public outreach programs, develop educational materials, and collaborate with local agencies, schools, and community organizations.

Key Responsibilities:

- Plan, develop, and implement stormwater management and environmental education programs for schools, local governments, and the general public.
- Lead outreach efforts to raise awareness about stormwater pollution, water conservation, and the importance of environmental stewardship.

- Ability to traverse uneven terrain in an outdoor environment and ability to carry and transport resource materials and equipment.
