





Comments/Uses: adaptable, bottomlands, timber, wildlife



Light Required: S
Soil Moisture: M
Soil pH: A

Comments/Uses: showy flowers, attracts wildlife, medicinal



White Oak

Mature Height: 50–70'
Mature Width: 50–70'
Growth Rate: S–M
Light Required: S, P
Soil Moisture: D, M, W
Soil pH: N

Comments/Uses: timber, wildlife, long-lived, ornamental

ADDITIONAL ITEMS



Wildflower Seeds

plant up to 200' sq. with perennials, grasses, and showy annuals



Rain Barrel*

stores up to 55 gallons of rain water; use to water plants and/or animals; fully plumbed



Tree Tube and Wood Stake*

4' height, improves seedling survival and reduces wildlife damage

Boundary Marking Paint*

8" wide aerosol spray, long-lasting, and fast-drying

Marking Flags*

21" metal shaft with 2.5" × 3.5" white flag

Dibble Bar*

Tapered thin wedge cast blade to quickly plant seedling trees

Geotextile*

A water-permeable material used to improve drainage, and reduce erosion. 12.5' wide, sold by linear foot

Growth Rate: F = fast, 12"+ /year, M = medium 6–12" /year, S = slow 2–6" /year

Light Required: S = sun, P = part sun/ part shade, SH = shade

Soil Moisture: D = dry, M = medium, W = wet

Soil pH: A = acidic (6.5 or less), N = normal pH range (6.5–7.5), B = basic/alkaline (7.5+)

FREE TREES FOR STUDENTS

Licking Soil & Water is offering free trees to students through the generous support of our sponsors, thank you! Seedling trees are given to elementary and middle school schools who serve Licking County students. We offer two options to schools to participate in this program that allows students to gain a sense of stewardship towards the land.

Option 1: Each student receives a white pine seedling tree to take home and plant in a location of their choosing. This option is ideal for schools where most students have a place at home to plant a tree.

Option 2: Requested seedling trees, including a variety of native species, are to be planted on school grounds. This

option is perfect for enhancing an outdoor classroom on the school property and to provide future learning experiences for students.

In addition to the seedling trees, each school will receive tree planting guides and educational resources to use in the classroom. Most importantly, the free seedling trees program is an opportunity to show students how vital trees are to their health, community, and the environment.
