Leave the Leaves

Fall is coming! That means colorful foliage, pumpkin spice lattes, and falling leaves. You may be itching to rake your leaves and kick them to the curb for pick-up...

DON'T

These Leaves serve an ecological purpose to pollinators and wildlife. Bees, moths, butterflies, and so many other insects will use this layer of leaf matter to survive through the winter. Rather than discarding your leaves, spread them on flower beds or garden to shelter these beneficial insects and nourish the soil as they decompose.

If you have leaves leftover after spreading... compost!





Septic Smart Week-September 15-19

The week of September 15-19 is to celebrate and educate on the proper care and maintenance of septic systems. The **EPA** aims to encourage communities to demonstrate public stewardship in wastewater treatment processes.

This program covers seven main tips for how to be "SepticSmart"

- Think at the Sink- Be conscientious of what you are putting in your sink
- Don't Strain Your Drain- Use water efficiently
- Keep It Clean- Test well water
- · Shield Your Field- Learn about your septic drainfield
- Protect It and Inspect It- Learn about inspection, frequency, and consider advanced systems
- Don't Overload the Commode- What to flush and what goes in the trash
- Pump Your Tank- Learn about pump-out services

If you have a septic system, it's essential to look into this information to save your tank!
