Through this amazing community-based conservation effort, a river system that had all but been abandoned has seen a beautiful rebirth of aquatic and birdlife.

Items pulled from the river over the years have included: thousands of tires, shopping carts, newspaper vending boxes, an old wagon wheel, upright piano, console television, hot water tank, washing machine, box springs, a very large teddy bear, bowling balls, vacuum cleaner, sofas, chairs, and on more than one occasion...the kitchen sink. These results illustrate the substantial environmental impact the Round Up has had on the water quality of the Licking River.

Clean-up locations include Newark, Heath, Pataskala, Union Township, Granville, Hebron, and the Dawes Arboretum. Options to be involved include paddling, wading, and riverside cleanups. Don't want to get wet? We also need help with registration in the morning and post-clean-up at the Soil & Water office Saturday afternoon.
