Conservation Mini-Grant



In celebration of Soil and Water's 75th Anniversary, the Board established a Community Mini-Grant program in 2019. Each year, the program offers up to \$1000 to Licking County non-profits, demonstrating the need and ability to carry out on-the-ground conservation projects.

The Mini-Grant program is open to non-profit organizations such as schools, watershed

groups, local government entities, municipalities, community groups, and civic associations within Licking County.

SepticSmart Week Sept. 16-20



SepticSmart Week is an annual event that occurs the third week of September. September 16- 20, 2024. The goal is to bring attention to the importance of caring for and maintaining septic systems.

This year SepticSmart Week is celebrating its 12th Anniversary!

Here are some smart tips for you to follow!

<u>Think at the Sink!</u> What goes down the drain has a big impact on your septic system. Fats, grease, and solids can clog a system's pipes and drainfield.

<u>Don't Overload the Commode!</u> A toilet is not a trash can. Disposable diapers and wipes, feminine hygiene products, coffee grounds, cigarette butts, and cat litter can damage a septic system.

<u>Don't Strain Your Drain!</u> Use water efficiently and stagger use of water-based appliances. Too much water use at once can overload a system that hasn't been pumped recently.

Shield Your Field! Tree and shrub roots, cars, and livestock can damage your septic drainfield.

<u>Keep It Clean!</u> Contamination can occur when a septic system leaks due to improper maintenance. Be sure your drinking water is safe to drink by testing it regularly.

<u>Protect It and Inspect It!</u> Regular septic system maintenance can save homeowners thousands of dollars in repairs and protect public health.

<u>Hanover Township Water Project – Arsenic concerns</u>

Ohio State and the Ohio Water Resource Center is conducting a study in the Hanover Township area to look at arsenic contamination in well water sources and potential treatment of those sources.
