For our 2025 River Roundup, we had a grand total of 277 volunteers spread across 12 different locations. We want to give a big thank you to all volunteers, sponsors, and partners who help to make this event such a big success each year.

#### This year we collected:

- 8,610 pounds of trash
- 174 tires
- 1,321 pounds of scrap metal

### Prime Time to Prep for a Prairie Planting

Strides are being made at the Soil and Water office towards creating a <u>Meadow for Monarchs</u>. The next step for us, spread wildflower seeds!

You may ask, why are you putting seeds down before winter? That's because in the natural process of seeding, the plants will drop seeds in the fall. This led to an adaptation called cold stratification. In order for these seeds to germinate they must go through this process to break dormancy.

So, if you are planning on having wildflowers make an appearance in the spring, ensure you research the proper techniques for planting.
